OVERVIEW



DIADURA was a fast-developing 2-year-old who quickly reeled off two impressive wins to begin her career. She broke her maiden on debut in a speedy :58.2 for 5 furlongs, and followed that up with an impressive 5 ½-length score in the Arlington-Washington Lassie, a race with a long history of revealing top-class talent. She was so well respected as a 2-year-old she went as the post-time favorite for the G1 Darley Alcibides. Her 3-year-old form shows consistency and soundness with 7 starts in 7 months, including a Stakes Placing in September. Her numbers indicate that she is headed to more Stakes races in 2018 for new connections.

RACE CAREER OVERVIEW

DIADURA established herself as one of the East Coast's leading 2-year-old fillies in her first two starts. She broke her maiden at first asking over 5 furlongs in last-to-first manner, beating subsequent 3X Stakes Winner and Graded Stakes Placed **Babybluesdancing**. She came back a month later with an incredible run in the Arlington-Washington Lassie Stakes. Breaking slowly, she stalked the field and, as they entered the stretch, Diadura muscled her way through an opening that most horses wouldn't dare consider and kicked clear to win by 5 ½ lengths. In that start she beat the very talented subsequent G2W Benner Island and Stakes Winner R Naja.

These two efforts made Diadura the 7-2 favorite in the premier G1 race for 2-year-old fillies on the East Coast leading up to the Breeders' Cup -- the G1 Darley Alcibiades. Breaking awkwardly, according to the official chart, she was forced out nine-wide by a rank Price Too High on the first turn and was never able to recover.

Diadura continued to progress as a sophomore for the Mike Stidham barn. Her multiple placings included a 3rd in the Richard Scherer Memorial Stakes to MSW Puntsville.

VS. OLDER FILLIES AND MARES - ENCOUNTERING LOTS OF TROUBLE




In her latest, **DIADURA** faced a stakes-quality field in a \$69k Keeneland allowance. She was "bothered and steadied in the stretch," according to the chart, was forced widest of all and, despite running 19 feet farther than the winner, finished with a nice kick.





PEDIGREE

DIADURA is out of **DAYTIME PROMISE**, a Stakes winner and 10 times Stakes-placed, including in the G2 Comely and G3 Next Move Handicap. In addition to **DIADURA**, she's the dam of three other winners, including the six-figure earner **GOLDEN SPEAR**. **DIADURA** has sire power behind her with **HARD SPUN**, **DANZIG'S** last G1-winning son. He has sired nine G1 winners, including females like the MG1W and Eclipse Champion 3-year-old filly **QUESTING (GB)**, MG1W **HARD NOT TO LIKE** and G1W **ZO IMPRESSIVE**. In 2017, **HARD SPUN** is represented by G1W **LE ROMAIN (AUS)**, G2Ws **PROMISING RUN** and **GATTING (AUS)**, and G3Ws **TIMELINE** and **NOMORERICHBLONDES**.

FIVE STAR DAY as a broodmare sire is having a strong 2017. Just this year he has been the broodmare sire of G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **GOOD MAGIC**, G3 Torrey Pines Winner **MUNNY SPENT**, G3 Marine Stakes winner **SOUPER TAPIT**, and the G2 West Virginia Derby 2nd **WHATEVERYBODYWANTS**. It is early days for **FIVE STAR DAY**, but he is showing the same prepotency as his own sire **CARSON CITY**, broodmare sire of seven champions and 42 graded winners, including greats like **BARBARO** and **HAVRE DE GRACE**.
